

iPad Editor Installation Instructions

Requires: Mac OS 10.3 or higher, Windows, or Linux; RAM 256 Mb.

Mac: download `http://<server URL or external ip address>:<Tomcat port>/ipad/iPadEditorMac.zip`, fully unzip the folder, and click on the iPad application to start iPad.

Snow Leopard users: you must type the following command into the Apple Terminal the first time you start iPad: `sudo arch -i386 "FolderLocation"/iPad.sh`, where "FolderLocation" is the location of the folder containing the iPad application (e.g., Applications/iPad). The Apple Terminal can be found in the folder Applications/Utilities.

Windows: download `http://<server URL or external ip address>:<Tomcat port>/ipad/iPadEditorWindows.zip`, fully unzip the folder, and click on iPad.exe to start iPad.

Linux: download `http://<server URL or external ip address>:<Tomcat port>/ipad/iPadEditorLinux.zip`, fully unzip the folder, cd iPad, enter "chmod +x iPad.sh" and "chmod +x jre/bin/java", and run iPad.sh to start iPad.

Access to the iPad Server

Login using the guest account. Now you can evaluate the system or create your own account using the User Manager command in the Tools menu (see Help for more information). You can also view your information on the Web via the iPad Portal: `http://<server URL or external ip address>:< Tomcat port>/ipad-web` (login required).
